

In the event CCF's Coleman Kids' Adventure Afterschool Program is closed due to a positive COVID case, the Program will transition to virtual programming. Please follow CCF Virtual After-school Program Expectations (Adapted from WED Reminders and Guidelines to Families on 5.20.20)

To the greatest extent possible under the circumstances, treat the virtual classroom like your regular building classroom. That means following all of the same rules that students would follow in the school building, like being on time to class and being respectful towards program staff and other students. Families are reminded that school policy prohibits the unauthorized recording of classes. Students who are found to be in violation of this policy, including by digitally recording a class on Google Classroom, may be subject to discipline.

Be mindful of the differences between the school building and the virtual classroom. With distance learning, it is possible that students who are participating in the virtual classroom will be physically near to others, such as parents, grandparents, and siblings. It is possible that these people will be able to see and hear the virtual classroom. It is also a possibility that someone may be recording the virtual classroom without authorization. We recommend that students find a quiet, private place to participate in virtual classes. Those in attendance at the virtual class should be limited, whenever possible, to the student and any support the student needs for learning – such as a parent or grandparent.

CCF staff will do their part to protect confidential student information. This means that no CCF staff member will share personally identifiable information about a student's education records, such as a student's grade, the fact that a student has an Individualized Education Program (IEP) or Section 504 Plan, or details about a student's IEP or 504 Plan, during virtual class time. Such confidential information will be shared on a one-on-one basis only. Families must also do their part to protect confidential student information. As a general rule of thumb, anyone attending a virtual class should refrain from doing or saying anything that they would not want others (including other students, their siblings, parents, grandparents, or friends) to see or hear (or, because it is impossible to fully prevent unauthorized recording, to record).

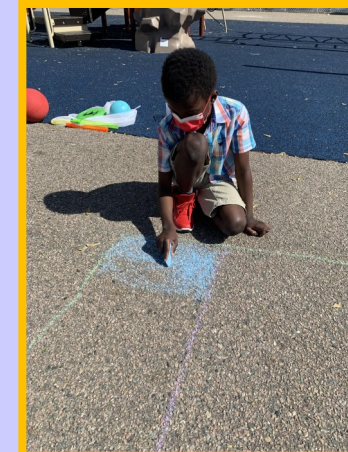
