How does it work?

Parents as Teachers is a free parent education program. Families can participate by having home visits, video visits, or phone visits.

Personal visits

Since this is *your* child and your family, you set the agenda for each personal visit. Your parent educator is there to provide well-researched information to help you make good parenting decisions, and to provide concrete support for you in times of need.

Groups

Group connections also create a network for you and other parents to learn and support each other, and grow together as parents.

Screenings

Regular screenings during your visits will make sure your child is healthy, safe, and developing on track.

Resources

Need more help or a special resource? Your parent educator will make the introduction and connect you.

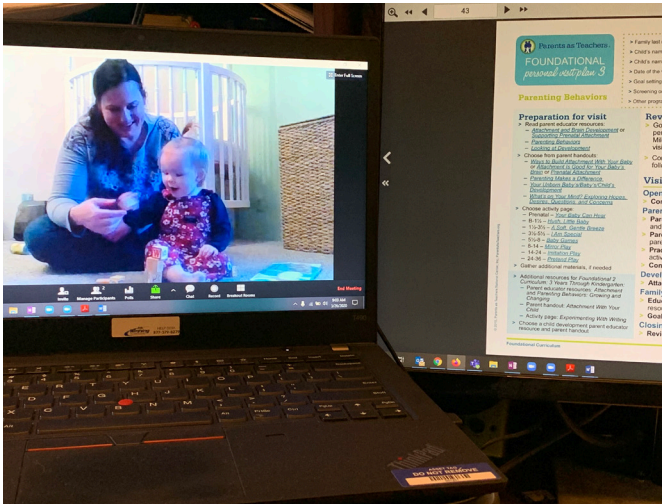

What do I need for video call visits?

When receiving virtual visits, you will need to have a camera-enabled device, like a laptop or a smart phone, and good internet connection. You'll also want a working email to be able to receive handouts electronically.

What do I need for phone call visits?

A working phone, cell service, and a data plan that allow ample time for the visits to occur is all you'll need for telephone visits.
